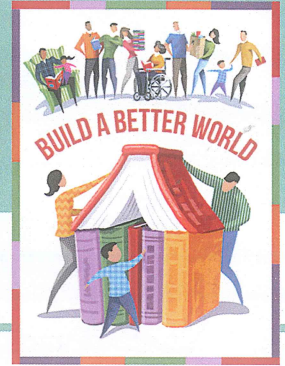




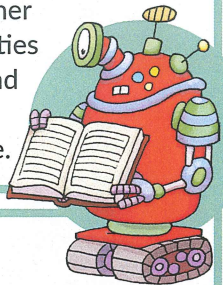

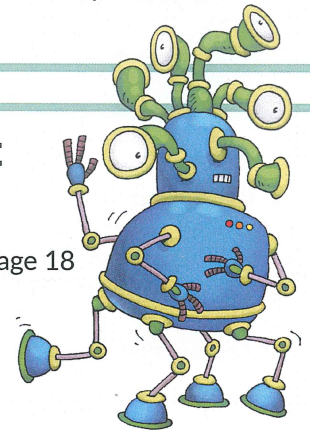


### Reading with the Rays

### Mayor's Reading Challenge

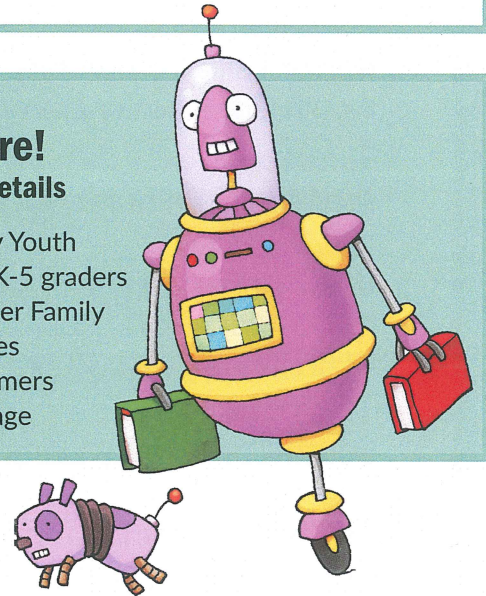

### Family Summer Reading Kick-Off June 4, 2-4 pm at Main Library

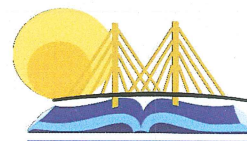
