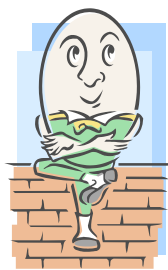
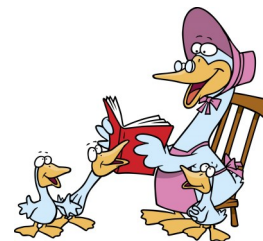
Bounce into Books
