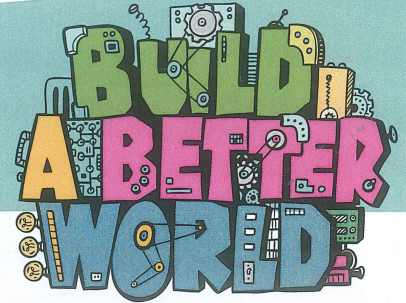




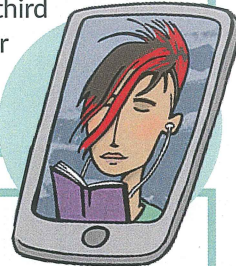

Family Summer Reading Kick-Off June 4, 2 to 4 pm at St. Petersburg Main Library

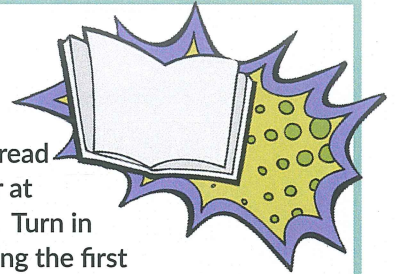

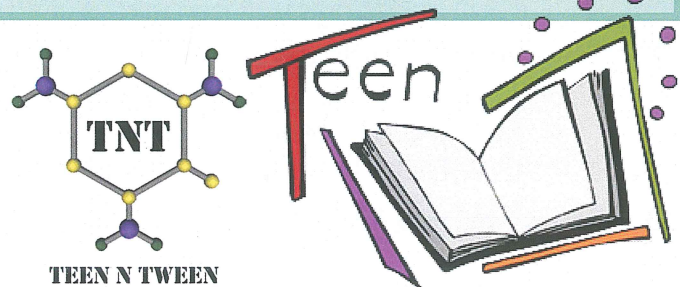
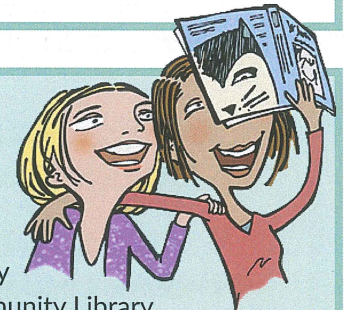
Chipotle Summer Reading Rewards

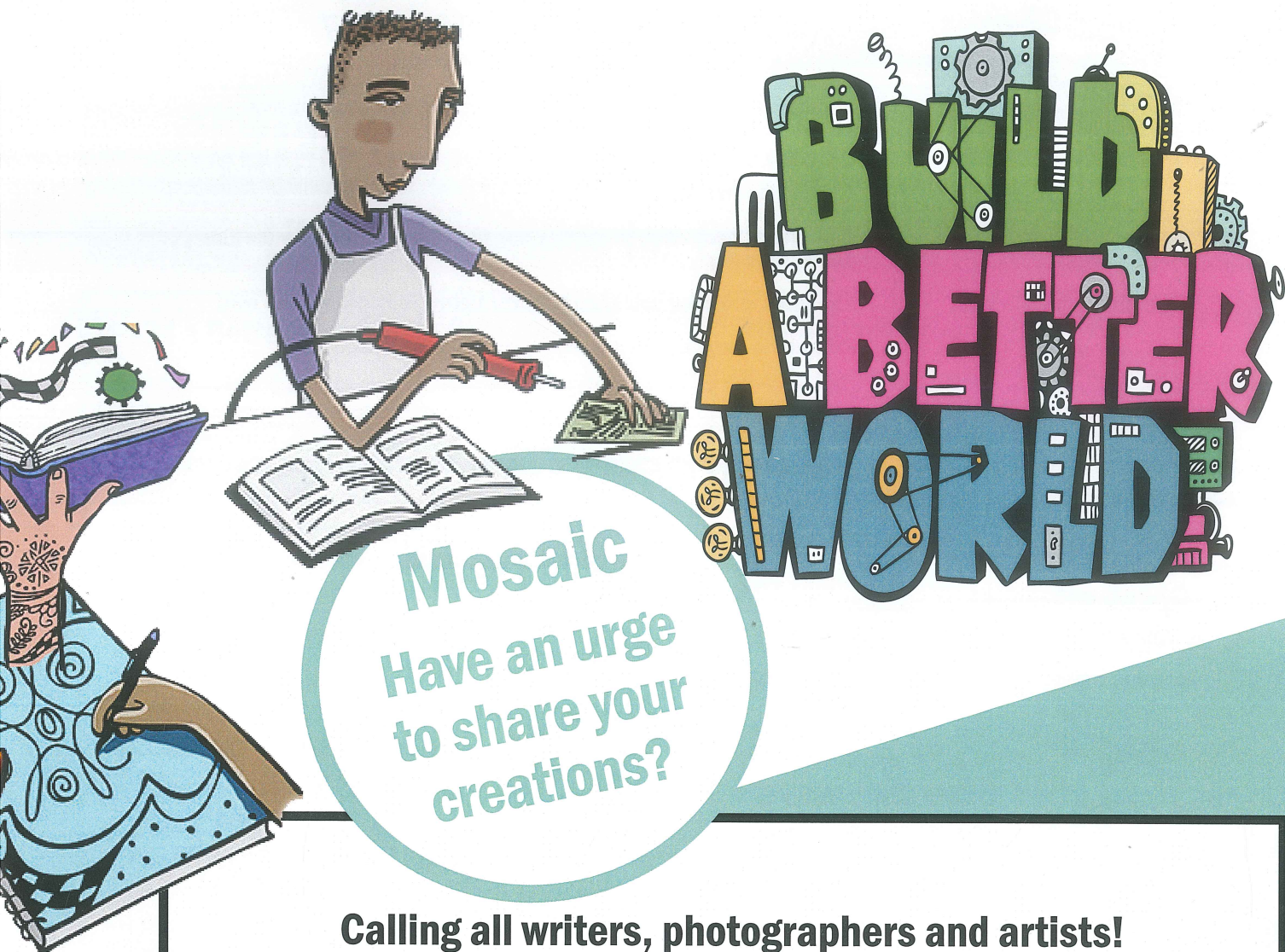

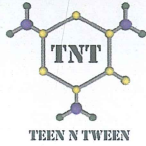
